### Terukuni Shrine

The greatest shrine in Kagoshima with an enormous Torii gate. A popular sightseeing spot especially during the New Year celebration and the Rokugatsu Lantern Festival. Admission to the shrine is free of charge.

### Amu Plaza Kagoshima

A large shopping mall with various stores. You can enjoy a view of Kagoshima City and Sakurajima from the mall's ferris wheel (Adults 500 yen, 3 year old - high school 300 yen).

### Bronze Statue of Okubo Toshimichi

A historical hero who lived during the late Edo period and Meiji period.

### Bronze Statue of Saigo Takamori

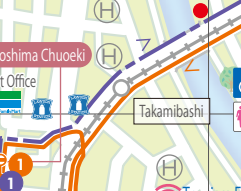
