



Access

Public Transportation

- 50 minutes from Kagoshima Airport by limousine bus. Get off at Kinseicho. Walk 15 minutes or take the bus and get off at Suizokukanmae or Sakurajima Sanbashi.
- 15 minutes by streetcar from JR Kagoshima Chuo Station. Get off at Suizokukanguchi, and walk 8 minutes.
- 15 minutes by bus from JR Kagoshima Chuo Station. Get off at Suizokukanmae or Sakurajima Sanbashi.
- Walk 15 minutes or take the bus from JR Kagoshima Station.

Using privately-owned cars

- In the case of using the Kyushu Expressway, get off at Satsuma Yoshida Interchange or Kagoshima Kita Interchange.
- ※ The parking lot has a limited capacity. Use public transportation means as much as possible.

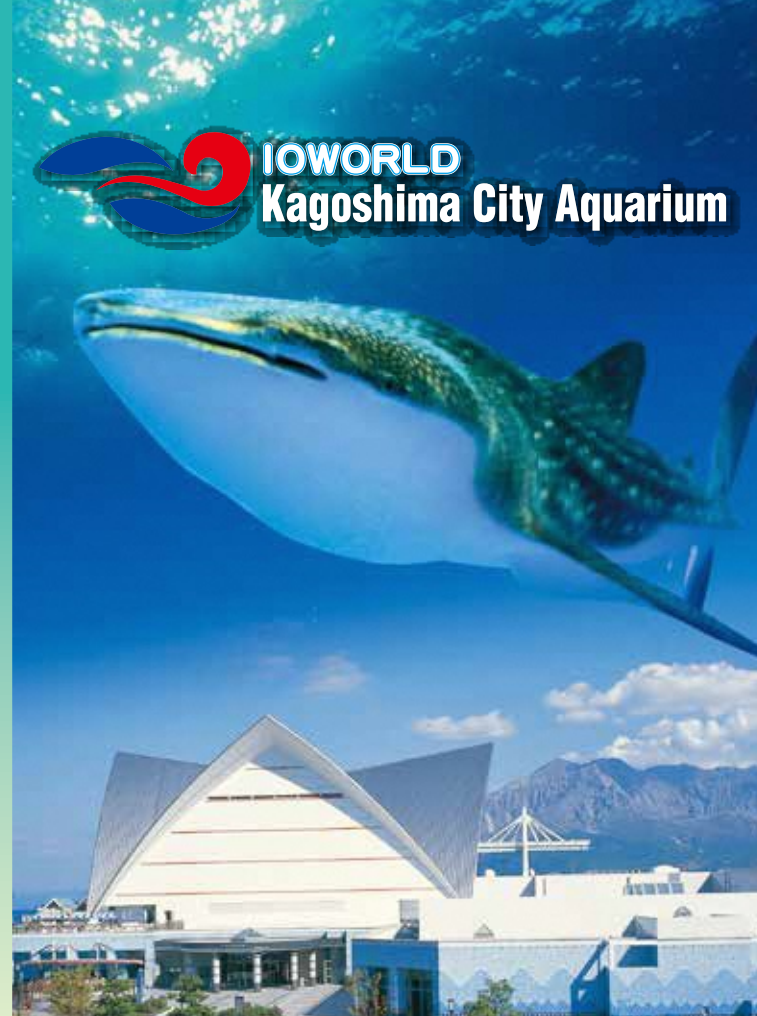

Sea of Nansei Islands (2nd fl.)

When you pass through the underwater tunnel, you can see the water tanks with coral reef and tropical fish in a wide variety.



Sea of Kuroshio Current (2nd fl.)

When you enter the aquarium, you will find the Kuroshio Great Water Tank first, where you can see large-sized fish swimming around calmly, including a whale shark, tuna, bonito, and ray.
